FOUNDATION OF THE CASE INFORMATION SYSTEM

- ✓ It was initiated by the eCommittee, Supreme Court of India.
- ✓ Developed by National Informatics Centre (NIC).
- ✓ Under eCourts Mission Mode Project (Phase I-III).
- ✓ By the Department of Justice, Government of India.



FIRST DEPLOYMENT

- ✓ The NIC began building the first version of CIS (CIS 1.0) around 2006–2007.
- ✓ It was designed as a standalone desktop-based application, deployed on a per-court basis (not networked or web-enabled).
- ✓ CIS 1.0 piloted in selected District and Sessions Courts across states like Punjab, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, and Maharashtra in the year 2007–2008.

- ✓ Reduce discretionary power through standardized workflows.

- ✓ Automate daily tasks: case listing, scheduling, cause list generation, etc.
- ✓ Support quicker case movement through stage-wise tracking.
- ✓ Minimize manual errors and procedural delays.



✓ **MONITORING & PERFORMANCE ANALYTICS**

Provide dashboards for judges and administrative heads to monitor:

- ✓ Case pendency
- ✓ Disposal rate
- ✓ Court performance



✓ INTEGRATION ACROSS THE JUSTICE ECOSYSTEM/STAKEHOLDERS

Facilitate seamless data exchange through platforms like Interoperable Criminal Justice System (ICJS) between:

- ✓ Ensure consistent reporting and tracking for High Courts and Supreme Court oversight.
